

EPISTLE READING

Prokeimenon. Plagal Fourth Mode. Psalm 18.4,1. Their voice has gone out into all the earth. Verse: The heavens declare the glory of God.


The reading is from St. Paul's Letter to the Romans 10:11-21; 11:1-2. Brethren, the scripture says, "No one who believes in God will be put to shame." For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek: the same Lord is Lord of all and bestows his riches upon all who call upon him. For, "every one who calls upon the name of the Lord will be saved." But how are men to call upon him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without a preacher? And how can men preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach good news!" But they have not all obeyed the gospel; for Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed what he has heard from us?" So faith comes from what is heard, and what is heard comes by the preaching of Christ. But I ask, have they not heard? Indeed they have; for "Their voice has gone out to all the earth, and their words to the ends of the world." Again I ask, did Israel not understand? First Moses says, "I will make you jealous of those who are not a nation; with a foolish nation I will make you angry." Then Isaiah is so bold as to say, "I have been found by those who did not seek me; I have shown myself to those who did not ask for me." But of Israel he says, "All day long I have held out my hands to a disobedient and contrary people." I ask, then, has God rejected his people? By no means! I myself am an Israelite, a descendant of Abraham, a member of the tribe of Benjamin. God has not rejected his people whom he foreknew.



CHURCH ETIQUETTE

The Sign of the Cross: Part 2

Anyone who looks around on a Sunday morning will notice that people make the sign of the Cross at different times (and sometimes in different ways). To a certain extent, when to cross oneself is a matter of personal piety rather than dogma. However, there are times when it is particularly appropriate—and times when it is not.

When to Cross

- · Whenever you hear one of the variations of the Trinitarian phrase: "Father, Son, and Holy Spirit."
- At the mention of a saint's name, invoking their intercessions.
- At the beginning and end of liturgical services.
- When beginning and ending your own private prayers.
- Before venerating an icon, the Cross, or the Gospel Book.
- · When entering or leaving the church.
- · When passing by a church or holy place.
- · When walking behind the Holy Altar Table (for acolytes).
- · When making a metanoia (a physical bow of reverence).

When Not to Cross

- · Immediately before the Holy Chalice (you may accidentally touch it-reverence instead while waiting your turn).
- · When being censed (simply bow your head).
- · When the priest or bishop blesses the congregation saying, "Peace be to all." (Bow slightly to receive the blessing rather than repeating it with your own cross.)
- · When receiving a blessing from a bishop or priest (kiss their right hand to receive the blessing; do not make the sign of the cross yourself).
